Central Region: February 28 - March 2, 2017 - Somerset County Emergency Services Training Academy, 402 Roycefield Road – Hillsborough

South Region: March 14 - 16, 2017 - Camden County College, 200 College Drive, Blackwood

North Region: April 4 - 6, 2017 - Passaic County Community College, Public Safety Academy, 300 Oldham Road, Wayne

NOTE: You must attend all three days to get the HSEEP Certificate.

Cost: free to attend

Target audience: healthcare and public health sector emergency preparedness personnel; other emergency management and emergency responders also welcome. Class size limited to 30 students.

Course prerequisites:

IS-120a: An Introduction to Exercises (mandatory; submit certificate with registration)

IS-100: Incident Command System (desirable)

IS-130: Exercise Evaluation and Improvement Planning (desirable)

General exercise experience (desirable)

Continuing Education: 19 contact hours/credits for NJ Public Health, EMT, Licensed Nursing Home Administrator (LNHA), and Certified Assisted Living Administrator (CALA); nursing CEs vary. You must be registered with NJLMN to receive all CEs.
