- IS-200: Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response (*most current version*)
- IS-700: An Introduction to the National Incident Management System (*most current version*)
- IS-800: National Response Framework (NRF), An Introduction (*most current version*)

Or

- IS-2200 Basic Emergency Operations Center Functions

G191 is a required course for the Advanced Professional Series (APS) certificate. *Enrollment is limited to 40 students.*
