Course Purpose:

HURREVAC is a decision-support tool used by official government emergency managers to assist with hurricane preparations and evacuation decision making. HURREVAC is a restricted-use computer program that couples hurricane evacuation study (HES) data with real-time weather forecasts from the National Hurricane Center. This combination allows users to graphically display local evacuation decision time guidance as hurricanes approach.
