Course Description:

The purpose of this professional development course, E-970 Supply Unit Leader (SPUL), is to provide local and State-level emergency responders with an overview of key duties and responsibilities of a Supply Unit Leader Type III in a Type III All Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT).

Target Audience

The intended audience(s) are local or state-level emergency responders who may be designated as Supply Unit Leader on their local or state Incident Management Team (IMT). The materials were developed with the assumption that audience members may have little or no actual experience as a member of an All Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT).

The audience may include participants from a variety of agencies and functional disciplines, including fire service, law enforcement, emergency management, public works departments, as well as public health organizations, medical emergency teams, and hospitals.

NIMS ICS specific training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to function, support, or unit leader positions on USFA or other Type III or IV All-Hazards Incident Management Teams (AHIMT) or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions.
